Please Welcome Bishop Lawson Bryan

Bishop Lawson Bryan retired in 2021 after 46 years of ministry, the last five of which he served as episcopal leader of the South Georgia Conference of The United Methodist Church. He previously served as senior pastor of Montgomery First United Methodist Church in Montgomery, AL, in the Alabama West-Florida Conference. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Tulane University and a doctorate in ministry from Candler School of Theology at Emory University. He is married to Sherrill, and their son Philip and daughter-in-law Brittany, along with their two grandchildren, John Phillip and Caroline Cooper "Cece," reside in Alabama.

An ordained elder in The United Methodist Church for more than 42 years, Bishop Bryan began his pastoral ministry as an associate pastor at Trinity United Methodist Church in Opelika, AL. He served as pastor for Hiland Park United Methodist Church in Panama City, FL; for Dexter Avenue United Methodist Church in Montgomery, AL; for First United Methodist Church in Brewton, AL, and for Ashland Place United Methodist Church in Mobile, Ala. He was senior pastor of First United Methodist Church in Dothan, AL; and First United Methodist Church in Montgomery, AL.

Bishop Bryan has served actively in the Church and in his community, including leading the Alabama-West Florida Conference Board of Ministry, serving on the Board of Trustees for Huntingdon College, serving as a General Conference delegate, and organizing and hosting an annual Pan-Methodist Pentecost Service in Montgomery. He also serves on the General Commission on Religion and Race.
