Eon, originally from Johannesburg, South Africa, holds a Master of Music in Organ (cum laude) from Stellenbosch University and additional diplomas in Organ Performance, Hymnology, and Church Music. This year celebrates his 30th year as organist. His career has taken him across continents, performing in New Zealand, the United Kingdom,

South Africa, and in the United States.

In 2019, he was an exchange student at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and fell in love with the Queen City. In 2020, he relocated to New Zealand where he was appointed Assistant Organist and Director of Communications at St Peter's Anglican Cathedral in Hamilton, concurrently taking on the role of music teacher at St Peter's School in Cambridge. However, his journey took him back to Charlotte in April 2023, where he is currently pursuing a Master of Divinity in Pastoral Care & Counseling, further enriching his multifaceted career in music and spirituality. The past year he was serving as Organist and Director of Handbells at Quail Hollow Presbyterian Church.
