The scholarship application at Matthews United Methodist Church is available for pickup in paper form upon request, or if you would like to work on it electronically, it can be found on the youth or young adult website at www.youth.matthewsumc.org under the College-Age tab or at youngadults.matthewsumc.org. **All applications must be returned by NOON on Friday, May 24.** This is a nonnegotiable deadline, therefore all applications received after the deadline by mail, in person, or e-mail will not be considered. Please be aware that only fully completed applications will be considered. Be sure to include all required elements. It is important to pay attention to each scholarship, because some of the criteria will vary.

When completing the Scholarship Application please be aware of the following:

- **APPLICATIONS MAILED, HAND DELIVERED TO THE CHURCH, OR EMAILED MUST BE TURNED IN NO LATER THAN NOON ON FRIDAY, MAY 24.**
- **All students must complete the Application form and Education Expense/Resource form.**
- **A separate application must be completed for each scholarship you are applying for.**
- **Attach a copy of the acceptance or enrollment letter from your anticipated/current school.**
- **Provide a current photograph attached to each application.**

Please be aware, hard copy application are preferred, but emailed applications will be accepted. If sending your application by e-mail, please send to Pastor Corey Milliet at corey@matthewsumc.org. If you are e-mailing your application, please send all components of the application at one time, do not send each required item separately.

Matthews United Methodist Church STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS 2023 CRITERIA

Carefully read criteria for the scholarship(s) you are applying for—there are specific and different requirements for each.

- I. Barnhardt Family Scholarship:** Made possible by the Caleb H. Barnhardt, Jr. family.
 - Dollar amount to be determined.
 - Recipient(s) or members of their immediate family must have been **members of MUMC** for at least **one year** before their enrollment in an accredited college or university.
 - Recipient(s) must be classified as an undergraduate or graduate student with a declared interest in studying **accounting, religion, or teaching**.
 - Recipient(s) must have **grades acceptable to their enrollment** or continuation in their college or university.
 - Applicant **must** submit a **brief written statement** providing some of the reasons you have chosen to pursue a degree in accounting, religion, or teaching.
 - Priority will be given to persons of high moral character and demonstrated financial need.

- II. Clois Fielding Winstead Memorial Nursing and/or Health Services Administration Scholarship:** This scholarship is given by her family in honor and memory of Clois Fielding Winstead and goes to support Nursing and Health Care Administration candidates in an Associate, BSN program or Health Services Administration program (undergraduate or graduate level).
 - Minimum amount of scholarship \$1,000 up to \$2,000 available.
 - Applicant must be in pursuit of a degree in one of the following areas: Nursing or Health Care Administration.
 - Applicant must be a member of MUMC or an active participant in the United Youth or United Young Adult Ministry.
 - Applicant must be enrolled in either an Associate Degree Nursing program, BSN program or Health Services Administration program.
 - Community College Students are eligible. *(If a current student, please note the number of years you have pursued this course of study).*
 - Applicant, please submit a brief (2 page max) written statement providing some of the reasons you have chosen to pursue a career in Nursing or Health Services Administration. This statement should include ways that the applicant demonstrates a caring, compassionate, and justice-centered mindset.
 - Applicants must show an academic achievement of at least a 3.0 GPA.

- III. Ira and Anna Williams Memorial Scholarship:** Made possible by funding from the family of Ira and Anna Williams.
- Scholarship will be \$1,000.00 (2 scholarships will be awarded)
 - Applicant must be an active member of MUMC.
 - Preferred undergraduate degree/ bachelor's degree candidates, but Graduate study applicants will also be considered.
 - Must be enrolled in an accredited institution in the pursuit of a degree in one of the following areas:
 - Early childhood, primary or secondary education
 - Music or music education.
 - Candidates may reapply for this scholarship as long as they are in their degree program.
 - Candidate should have a strong academic record with minimum 3.0 GPA.
 - Applicants must be of good character, have true financial need for scholarship, demonstrate traits of caring, compassion, justice, and academic achievement.
 - Applicant must submit a brief (2 Page Max.) written statement providing some of the reasons why you have chosen to pursue a career in education or music. This statement must demonstrate a similar commitment to the importance of music and education as it did to Mr. & Mrs. Williams, as well as display some of the other attributes that the family loved about Ira & Anna:
 - Caring and selfless, who always put the needs of others before themselves.
 - Always hard workers, sacrificing of themselves for their family and friends
 - People of grit, who could face obstacles and set-backs, unwavering in their trust in God to make a path for them forward.
 - People who loved children and saw them for what they could be in spite of their current situations
 - Humble people who worked for God's glory not their own

- IV. Jeanette VanBoskerck Vickers Memorial Scholarship:** This scholarship is given in honor and memory of Jeanette VanBoskerck Vickers, and goes to support nursing candidates in an Associate or BSN program.
- Scholarship amount is \$500.00 per semester, distributed over 4 semesters, for a total of \$2,000. (Subject to availability of funds.)
 - Applicant **must be a member of MUMC or an active participant in the United Youth or United Young Adult Ministry.**
 - Applicant must be **enrolled in either an Associate Degree Nursing program or in a BSN program.** [Community College Students are eligible at the beginning of study for the first 2 years of study ONLY. Four year BSN students are ONLY eligible for Junior or Senior year.] - **Please note how many years you have been in this course of study on your application.**
 - Applicants must remain enrolled in the nursing program in order to receive the scholarship each semester.
 - Applicant **must** submit a brief (2 Page Max.) **written statement** providing some of the reasons you have chosen to pursue a in nursing. This statement must include ways that the applicant demonstrates a caring, compassionate, and justice centered mindset.
 - Applicants must show an academic achievement of at least a 3.0 GPA.

- V. Jeremiah 29:11 Scholarship:** Made possible by funding given in thanksgiving for parents and grandparents who taught the value of education and who modeled a life of Christian service.
- Scholarship will be \$1,000.00. (2 scholarships will be awarded).
 - Applicant must be an active participant in the MUMC United Youth or United Young Adult Ministry.
 - Applicant must be accepted by, or enrolled in, an accredited institution of higher learning including:
 - 4-year institution of higher learning
 - Community college
 - Vocational/Technical school
 - Applicant must have a demonstrated financial need.
 - Applicant must submit a brief written statement describing which coursework they are most looking forward to, and why.
 - This scholarship is granted for one year. Recipients are eligible to re-apply for additional year(s).

- VI. Justin Tanger Memorial Scholarship:** Made possible by funding from the family and friends of Justin Tanger.

- Minimum amount of scholarship will be \$1,000.00.
- Applicant must be a **member of MUMC**.
- Applicant must be **accepted by** or **enrolled in** an **undergraduate or graduate program** at an accredited college or university.
- Applicant must be full-time student in the field of Special Education, a field related to Special Education or in the field of Mental Health.
- Applicants must maintain a **2.5 grade point average**.
- Applicants must have a **demonstrated financial need**.

- VII. Michael R. Maloney Memorial Scholarship:** Made possible by funding from the family and friends of Michael R. Maloney.

- Minimum amount of scholarship will be \$500.00.
- Applicant must be a **member of MUMC**.
- Applicant must be **accepted by** or **enrolled as a full-time student in an undergraduate program at an accredited college or university**.
- Applicants must maintain a **2.5 grade point average**.

- VIII. Sylvia Strong Scholarship:** Established in memory of Sylvia Strong and administered by the Family Covenant Adult class, her friends and family.

- Scholarship amount to be determined.
- Applicant will be selected with priority given to the following intended majors **in the following order**:
 1. Teaching
 2. Liberal Arts
 3. Any other disciplines
- Applicant **must be a member of MUMC**. Priority given to those with financial need.



IX. UMW College/Continuing Education Scholarship: Made possible by funding from the Matthews United Methodist Church United Methodist Women.

- Amount of scholarship \$1,000.00. (2 scholarships will be awarded)
- The scholarship will be awarded to up to two **female** members of our congregation who are pursuing higher education in an undergraduate level program. The awarding of this scholarship is based on the criteria listed below and the point value indicated for each category.

1. **Membership in MUMC** (required)
2. **Acceptance by an institution of higher learning including:** (required)
 - a) 4-year institution of higher learning
 - b) Community college
 - c) Vocational/Technical school
3. **Need for financial assistance** (15 points)
4. **Exhibiting Christian leadership by:** (35 points)
 - a) Involvement in MUMC & church related functions
 - b) Involvement in other Christian clubs
 - c) Involvement in outreach activities
5. **Completion of written essay:** (50 points)
 - a) Topic: My College/Continuing Education Will Benefit God's World Because...
 - b) Length of essay: at least **500 words**

ALL Scholarships are granted for one year, but recipients are eligible to re-apply the following year. An interview may be scheduled as part of the application process.
