Florence Beatrice Price (1887–1953) was an American composer, pianist, and teacher. The first African-American woman recognized as a symphonic composer, she was also the first to have a work performed by a major orchestra. She wrote over 300 pieces, and in 2009, a trove of her works was discovered in her abandoned summer home.
