

5th SUNDAY IN LENT - THE SIGN

Today the sign "INRI" is placed on the CROSS. The letters "INRI" are the initial letters for the words in Latin: Jesus (Jesus); Nazarenes (of Nazareth); Rex (King); Iudaeorum (of the Jews). The Jews had told Pilate that Jesus claimed to be



The Jews had told Pilate that Jesus claimed to be king. Pilate ordered a **SIGN** be made on which was inscribed the crime for which he sentenced Jesus to die: Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews. Pilate orderedthe SIGN to be carried by a solider in front of Jesus on the way to the place of crucifixion and to be nailed to the cross above Jesus' head. This **SEASON OF LENT**, we find ourselves in the presence of the **ONE** who followed the **SIGN**. May we always remember!
