PASSION/PALM SUNDAY - THE DRAPE

Purple is the traditional color associated with Lent. It is a color rich in symbolism. It is a deep, almost night-like color that focuses our thoughts on the fasting and repentance associated with the Lenten season. It is also a color of royalty, particularly the Roman emperors at the time of Christ. As an act of derision toward Our Lord, Pilate placed a purple robe on Jesus, whom he called "King of the Jews". *THE DRAPE* is a symbol representing Christ's royal lineage and focuses our attention on his suffering.

Although Lent is a time of somber reflection and sacrifice, the purple *DRAPE* reminds us of the hope of Christ's upcoming resurrection. Easter is approaching!
